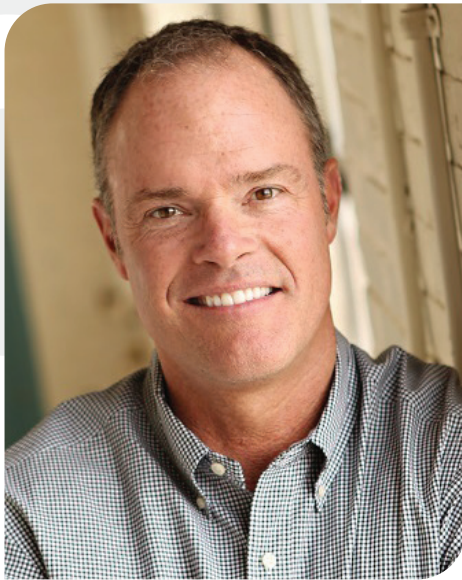


Joe Humphries
